## Trauma-Informed Care

Skilled nursing facilities that receive government funding must now implement trauma-informed care.

This is a wide-reaching strategy that involves identifying trauma, responding appropriately, and avoiding environments that could re-traumatize patients.

## Culturally Competent Care

Skilled nursing facilities are seeing increasing interest in <u>culturally</u> <u>competent care</u>—the ability to effectively interact with different belief systems and practices.

## Staffing Requirements and PBJ Reporting

CMS now uses <u>payroll-based</u> journal reporting to evaluate staffing levels. Starting this year, nurse and administrator turnover can affect quality ratings. Insufficient staffing may hurt a facility's 5-star rating. To protect their rating, facilities need to keep recruiting efforts up and turnover down.
